NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$0.08666 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Emergency Services District #1.

PROPOSED TAX RATE \$0.08666 per \$100 NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE \$0.04868 per \$100 VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE \$0.05047 per \$100 DE MINIMIS RATE \$0.08666 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2024 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Emergency Services District #1 from the same properties in both the 2023 tax year and the 2024 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Emergency Services District #1 may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate, unless the de minimis rate for Emergency Services District #1 exceeds the voter-approval rate for Emergency Services District #1.

The de minimis rate is the rate equal to the sum of the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate for Emergency Services District #1, the rate that will raise \$500,000, and the current debt rate for Emergency Services District #1.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Emergency Services District #1 is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2024 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON August 15, 2024 AT 4:00 PM AT Marlin Volunteer Fire Department.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the voter approval tax rate but not greater than the de minimis rate. However, the proposed tax rate exceeds the rate that allows voters to petition for an election under Section 26.075, Tax Code. If Emergency Services District #1 adopts the proposed tax rate, the qualified voters of the Emergency Services District #1 may petition the Emergency Services District #1 to require an election to be held to determine whether to reduce the proposed tax rate. If a majority of the voters reject the proposed tax rate, the tax rate of the Emergency Services District #1 will be the voter-approval tax rate of the Emergency Services District #1.
